- 3) Item a) under 6.3 QUALIFICATIONS OF SECURITY GUARDS (page 67) should be read as follows:

- a) Must be at least HIGH SCHOOL Graduate, of good moral character/reputation, alert and without any criminal or derogatory police record.
- 4) Pursuant to Item b, Section 4 (Service Agreements) of DOLE Department Order No. 150-16 entitled “**Revised Guidelines Governing the Employment and Working Conditions of Security Guards and Other Private Security Personnel in the Private Security Industry**”, which provides

***“b. The place of work and terms and conditions governing the contracting arrangement which shall include the agreed amount of the security services to be rendered and the standard administrative fee of not less than twenty percent (20%) of the total contract cost”***

Hence, for this procurement, the Agency Fee/Administrative Fee shall not be less than twenty percent (20%).

- 5) The Approved Budget for the Contract appearing in Item 13.1 under 13. APPROVED BUDGET FOR THE CONTRACT (page 70) and INVITATION TO BID (page 6) is revised to **Forty-Two Million Eight Hundred Forty Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty-Nine and 28/100 Pesos (Php42,840,759.28)**.
